1. *Mahat-sarga*, principle of intelligence

Ahaṅkāra

(principle of self-consciousness)

2. *Bhūta-sarga*, subtle elements, from which arise the great elements
3. *Indriya-sarga*, sense faculties, action faculties, and mind
